In addition to the panels, there will be interactive demonstrations enabling attendees to see how technology can be used and deployed in the real world.

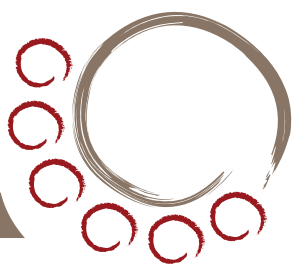
